ALLOWABLE SIGNS

1. Building or Ground Signs which received a building permit from the City of Destin
2. Signs of two square feet or less as long as the sign is not a prohibited sign.
3. Signs carried by a person.
4. Flags – rectangular shape attached to flag pole.
5. Directional Sign – four square feet.

ALLOWABLE TEMPORARY SIGNS

1. A real estate sign not exceeding 32 square feet of sign face area or eight feet in height.
2. A grand opening sign not exceeding 32 square feet of sign face area or eight feet in height, provided that said sign shall not be displayed for more than 14 days during any 12 consecutive calendar months.
3. A construction sign not exceeding 32 square feet of sign face area or eight feet in height. Such sign shall not be displayed more than 60 days prior to the beginning of actual construction of the project, and shall be removed no later than the date of the issuance of a certificate of occupancy for all or any portion of the project. If a sign is displayed pursuant to this section, but construction is not initiated within 60 days after the sign is displayed, or if construction is discontinued for a period of more than 60 days, the sign shall be removed, pending the initiation or continuation of construction activities.
4. A sign for a premises that has no permanent sign provided that such temporary sign shall not exceed 32 square feet in sign face area nor eight feet in height. Such sign may be displayed for a period of 60 days or until installation of a permanent sign, whichever shall occur first.
