Yellow oil-containment boom can be dangerous to swimmers and boaters. Boom can also be made ineffective by boat wake. Boom can be damaged or destroyed by a collision with boats or jet skis.

CPE is deploying boom as a precaution.

We need your cooperation to make boom deployment and operation go smoothly. When operating your boat near boom use slow speeds to create minimum wake. Also, stay in the navigation channel to reduce the effects of wake on the boom system. If you get close to the boom, currents can sweep you into the boom before you know it, damaging the boom and your boat. So stay safe and help protect the environment.

***Stay in the channel and watch your wake by traveling at slower speeds.**

***Avoid boating or swimming near boom.**
