

DECLARATION OF STATE OF CIVIL EMERGENCY –
HURRICANE SALLY

On this 14th day of September, 2020, at 5:30pm, the City Manager of the City of Destin, Florida (the “City”) hereby declares that a State of Civil Emergency hereby exists within the City due to the expected impact of Hurricane Sally on the City.

WHEREAS, based on information received regarding Hurricane Sally from the National Weather Service, the National Hurricane Center, and the Okaloosa County Emergency Management Department, the City is expected to receive heavy winds, rainfall, storm surge and other weather related phenomena within its incorporated limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the recitals above, all of which are incorporated herein below, the City Manager hereby declares a State of Civil Emergency due to the expected impact of Hurricane Sally on the City and further states:

Section 1. Boundaries of the areas affected by the Civil Emergency.

This State of Civil Emergency encompasses the City’s entire municipal bounds.

Section 2. Powers.

The City shall have the right to exercise the full complement of powers afforded to the City through its broad constitutional home rule powers, any executed order issued by the Governor, any powers described in Florida Statutes, including, but not limited to § 252.38, Florida Statutes, and any powers described in the City’s Code, including, but not limited to Chapter 8, Articles II and III.

Section 3. Course of Action.


This State of Civil Emergency shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until the emergency no longer exists. The City Manager shall continue monitoring the affects of Hurricane Sally on the City

Section 4. Procurement and Purchasing Policy Suspended.

All normal procurement and purchasing procedures are hereby suspended if the procurement is reasonably related in any way to mitigating the effects of Hurricane Sally.

Section 5. Direction to City Staff.

This State of Civil Emergency shall be disseminated to the appropriate City agencies, the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office, the Okaloosa County Board of County Commissioners, the local news media, and the general public as soon as possible.
