 - g. An offense under Chapter 895, *Florida Statutes* (Racketeering and illegal debts); or
 - h. Any of the foregoing statutory offenses as amended from time to time.
- 2) An offense against an analogous Federal statute or the statutes of a state other than Florida, that had predicate act(s) been committed in Florida they would have constituted any of the foregoing offenses.
- 3) Attempt, solicitation, or conspiracy to commit one of the foregoing statutory offenses.

A Conviction that is later reversed, vacated, overturned or expunged by a court of law shall not be considered a specified criminal act under this section.

1. By applying for a license, the Applicant shall be deemed to have read and consented to the Sexually Oriented Business provisions of Chapter 2.5 of the City of Destin Code of Ordinances and to the exercise of their responsibilities under said Chapter 2.5.
 2. The omission, falsification, or incorrectness of any information required for this application will constitute an incomplete application and the City will return the incomplete application to the applicant for completion.

I hereby swear or affirm that all the information contained in this application is true and correct. I hereby represent that I have the lawful right and authority to file this application. I acknowledge and agree that I am under the continuing duty and obligation required in Section 2.5-45 of the City Code to supplement this application with any and all changes or alterations in the information or disclosures required in this application within fourteen (14) days of a change in circumstances which would render the information originally submitted false, incomplete, or outdated.

I understand that submission of this application initiates a process and does not imply approval by the City of Destin. I understand that is unlawful for any person applying for a Sexually Oriented Business Employee license to make a false or misleading statement or provide false or misleading information, which is intended to facilitate the issuance of a license.

I also understand and agree that upon submitting a fully completed application, I will be immediately granted a temporary license and that within thirty (30) days the City will make a final decision as to whether I qualify for an annual sexually oriented employee license under Chapter 2.5 of the City Code. You also understand and agree that should I not qualify for an annual license, I will not be eligible to work in a sexually oriented.
