DYSL Official 8 & Under Playing Recommendations

Law 1 – Field of Play

Length - 60 yards **Width** – 40 yards

Field Markings – Goal Area 6 yards by 16 yards; 8-yard radius center circle;

Build out lines – Build out lines will be placed between the goalie box and the half line, indicating where your players must stand behind while the other teams goalie has possession of the ball.

Goals- 12 Ft. wide by 6.5 Feet High

Law 2 - Ball - Size 3

Law 3 - Number of players – 7 on 7. Substitutions- will normally occur between the quarters and at halftime: however, a player may be substituted at any time if an injury causes a need for substitution. Substitutions must enter and exit the field only with the permission of the referee.

Law 4 – Player’s equipment – Shin guards under and fully covered by socks are mandatory

Law 5 – Referee – City will supply the referee

Law 6 – Assistant referee- Not Used

Law 7 - Duration of the game – 4 quarters of 10 minutes each with 5-minute half-time and 2- minute breaks between quarters 1&2 and 3&4

Law 8 - Start of Play – Conform to F.I.F.A., except that opponents must be 5 yards from the center mark when kick-off is in progress. The team that kicks off at the start of the game also kicks off at the beginning of the second quarter. The other team kicks off after half-time and at the beginning of the fourth quarter. Teams switch ends at the half

Law 9 – Ball In and Out of Play- Conform to F.I.F.A.

Law 10 - Method of Scoring- Conform to F.I.F.A.

Law 11 - Offside’s- There shall be no off-side enforced

Law 12 – Fouls and Misconduct – Conform to F.I.F.A., except slide tackling is not allowed. Slide tackling includes any intentional slide by a player, with or without the ball, with an opponent or a teammate in the vicinity. Penalty for slide tackling or attempt to do so is an indirect free kick for the opposing team. The referee must explain all infractions to the offending player. No Cautions or send-offs shall be issued but the referee may ask the coach to remove the player, if necessary. An indirect free kick will be awarded to the opposing team when a player charges a goalkeeper in the goal area- whether or not the ball is in goalkeeper’s possession

Law 13- Free Kicks – Conform to F.I.F.A., except all free kicks are indirect and opponents must be 5 yards from the ball. Any free kick awarded to the attacking team within its opponent’s goal area shall be taken from the part of the goal area line which runs parallel to the goal line at the point nearest to where the offense was committed

Law 14 - Penalty Kicks- None

Law 15 - Throw-ins - Conform to F.I.F.A., except a player making an incorrect throw-in will be allowed a second throw-in after the referee explains the error in the first attempt

Law 16 - Goal Kicks - Conform to F.I.F.A., except that opponents must be 5 yards from the ball and outside the goal area and the ball must leave goal area to be in play

Law 17 - Corner Kicks – Conform to F.I.F.A., except opponents must be 5 yards from the ball

Advantages of playing Small-Sided Games

>More time with the coach

>Energetic workouts due to playing both offense and defense

>Matches can be played simultaneously across a full-sized field

>children are physically more efficient in smaller space

>Children are actively involved for a longer period of time

>It takes less time to score a goal or advance to goal

>Greater success rate for the players

US Youth Soccer Recommendations

- Opposing coaches, players and parents should shake hands after every match (Parent’s Tunnel)
- Parent/Coaches, spectators should be there to enjoy and encourage
- No slide tackles
